REGISTRATION

It is important that every parent (including returning families and new families) come for final registration on May 3rd between 1:30 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. in the Cafeteria. The 2nd part of registration fees and all other fees are required to be paid on that day. Additional forms are also filled out at this time. *Every* parent must be seen on this date. Forms and payment must be fully completed within 5 working days of that date or a \$25.00 late fee will be assessed. Late fee will begin on May 11th.

TUITION AND FEES

Remember: all outstanding fees (library fines, damaged textbook fines, band fees) and delinquent tuition must be paid in full by May 12th. Only cash or money orders will be accepted after May 12th. Report cards will be held until all tuition and fines are paid.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

If you will be applying for tuition assistance you must do so through FACTS by April 15th so that we will have information to you by May 3rd, for final registration.



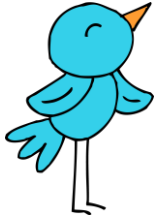
